Dear Mr. Mackay;

The Information and Privacy Commissioner of Ontario, would like to expand the purchase agreement IPC16P002, currently between Nortak and ourselves. Nortak will provide expert advisory services for our new Enterprise Information Management System which was described in "Part 7 – Optional Services – Transition Assistance and Support Services", of the Legislative Assembly's RFP 16P-002.

The IPC will also reimburse you for reasonable transportation and accommodation costs related to your travel between Toronto and Ottawa, to an maximum of \$15,000, this will be paid monthly once provided with detailed receipts.
